CLUB SELECTION

This task becomes more and more difficult as our Club goes from strength-to-strength. We are fully aware that a lot of players will not be selected for this Sundays' tournament as it is simply impossible to select every single player. However, preference has been given to those players who have regularly attended training.

U10 BOYS

James Lankfer has selected a squad of 8/9 players for the U10 Boys team. Players who are very young have not been selected as they will have a chance to participate next season and in some cases the following seasons.

U10 GIRLS

The U10 Girls have a squad of 9 players selected by Phil Clegg. As with the U10 Boys only the winners will qualify for the regional rounds so you will need to win as many matches as possible.

U12 BOYS

Two U12 Boys teams have been selected by James Lankfer. Peter Jarvis will be looking after one team and I will be looking after the other. The winners and runners-up will qualify for the regional rounds.

U12 GIRLS

We have entered 3 x U12 Girls teams of 9 players per squad, so in total 27 players. As with the boys, the winners and runners up will qualify for the regional rounds on 16th April at Harleston Magpies. There will be Roger Wilson, James Lankfer and myself looking after the 3 teams. The 'C' team will be predominantly younger players in preparation for next season. If we are fortunate to progress to the regional rounds, players will be selected from all 3 teams and not just the 'A' team.
